
Take a load off and kick back—**no Weekly Update this time** because this Monthly Update has all the stuff you need. So, grab your favorite beverage, settle in, and catch up!






August 2 – JR Shaggers Summer Workshop at Spartanburg Shrine Club, hosted by Upstate Shag Club. See the flyer below!

Dec 5 – ECSC Christmas Party at Palmetto Event Center. Save the date—this one's going to sparkle!



Our AED & Why It Matters

History – Incase you missed the Membership Meeting before the Vinyl Party here is a little recap - I've recently been shared some history on how our club AED (Automated External Defibrillator) was obtained. Very briefly - in 2019 a man was dancing at Fat Harold's at the end of SOS Mid-Winter and he suddenly went down to the floor with no pulse. Help quickly gathered around and CPR began. An AED was retrieved and connected to the man and used several times until a pulse was achieved. This event was witnessed by our own Lisa Caveny. Lisa then wrote an article for Carefree Times about this event. In 2021 Lisa also wrote a letter to the SOS Charitable Foundation about this event and brought to light that our membership is getting to the age where the use of an AED is more likely needed. The SOS Charitable Foundation wrote a check to ECSC for \$1500 on September 25,2021.


When the Fun Monday event expenses are all paid the remainder goes to SOS Charitable Foundation Inc. and Caring For Kids of Horry County. Some of the proceeds indirectly at that point came back to ECSC so that we have our own AED to use at our events should we need it. This spring there were 12 ECSC members that took AED & CPR training, some for a refresher and some for the first time.

Got Ideas? We're always looking for ways to make our club better. Got a suggestion? Want to lead an event? Just want to say hi? Talk to any board member—we're all ears.


